Important voting rules you should know:

Each member has one vote. A husband and wife, or life partners, who are both members each has one vote. If you want to vote by proxy, you should sign and date this proxy card and return it so that it is received at the Temple office no later than 3:00 pm on May 13th. Each voter must sign his or her own proxy. For example, a husband and wife who both want to vote by proxy must each sign a separate proxy.

You may withdraw or revoke this proxy at any time before the vote is taken at the meeting. To do so, you must deliver written notice to the Temple office directed to the Secretary of the Congregation, Rachel Eckhaus, stating that you want to revoke your proxy. You will also have the opportunity to revoke your proxy by attending the meeting and stating at the meeting that you want to vote in person. Even if you sign a proxy, you may still attend the meeting. Attending the meeting does not automatically revoke your proxy.
