

Heather G. Stoltz is a fiber artist who creates quilted wall hangings and fabric sculptures inspired by social justice issues, Jewish texts, and life experiences. Her work has been exhibited nationally and featured in *Quilts and Human Rights*, *Jewish Threads*, and several other publications. Stoltz, named as one of The Jewish Week's "36 Under 36" for 2012, received a 2011 Manhattan Community Art Funds grant for Temporary Shelter, her installation piece about homeless New Yorkers.
