

One of the most in-demand bassists in New York City, Jeff Carney's resume reads like a "who's who" of the world's elite artists. As an accompanist, Carney has been heard alongside jazz greats Stan Getz, Bobby McFerrin (2014-15 world tour), Art Farmer and Freddie Hubbard and pop icons such as Sting, James Taylor, Billy Joel, Andrea Bocelli and Elton John. He has performed with Barbra Streisand on her last six tours and her recent performance at The Village Vanguard. Jeff is principal bassist for the New York Pops Orchestra at Carnegie Hall, has appeared as a featured bassist with the New York Philharmonic and San Francisco Symphony, as well as numerous chamber music concerts and music festivals worldwide.

Jeff has been heard in pit orchestras for several Broadway productions, including Beauty and the Beast, Cyrano, The Secret Garden, Anything Goes and the 2014 production of Les Miserables.

Currently, he can be heard on NPR as a band member of Garrison Keillor's Prairie Home Companion national broadcast.

As a studio player, he can be found on many film soundtracks, Mr. Holmes, True Grit, featured bassist for Julie & Julia, The Good Shepard, Secret Window, Shaft 2 and The Producers to name a few.
