## Hanukkah Blessings

Candles are added to the *hanukkiyah* (Hanukkah *menorah*) from right to left but are kindled from left to right. The newest candle is lit first. (On Shabbat, kindle the Hannukah candles first and then the Shabbat candles.)

Light the shamash (helper candle) first, using it to kindle the rest of the Hanukkah candles. As you do, say or sing:

Baruch atah, Adonai Eloheinu, Melech ha'olam, asher kid'shanu b'mitzvotav vʻtzivanu l'hadlik ner shel Hanukkah.

Blessed are you, Eternal our God, Source of the universe, who teaches us ways of holiness, and calls us to kindle the Hanukkah lights.

## בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְיָ אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, שֶׁעְשָׂה נִסִּים לַאֲבוֹתֵינוּ בַּיָּמִים הָהֵם בַּזִּמֵן (מּוּבַזִּמֵן) הַזֵּה.

Baruch atah, Adonai Eloheinu, Melech ha'olam, sheh-asah nisim la-avoteinu bayamim ha-heim baz'man (uvaz'man) hazeh.

Blessed are you, Eternal our God, Source of the universe, who performed miracles for our ancestors in days of old (and) at this season.

## On the first night only:

בָּרוּך אַתָּה יְיָ אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, שֶׁהֶחֶיָנוּ וְקִיְּמְנוּ וִהָגִּיעָנוּ לַזִּמֵן הַזֵּה.

Baruch atah, Adonai Eloheinu, Melech ha'olam, sheh-heh-cheh-yanu v'kiy'manu v'higianu laz'man hazeh.

Blessed are you, Eternal our God, Source of the universe, for giving us life, for sustaining us, and for enabling us to reach this season.
