Each voter must sign his or her own proxy. For example, a husband and wife who both want to vote by proxy must each sign a separate proxy.

You may revoke this proxy at any time by sending an email to the Secretary of the Congregation, Liz Mayeri, at BoardSecretary@nykolami.org, stating that you want to revoke your proxy. If you revoke your proxy prior to the commencement of the meeting, you will not be counted towards the quorum, and you will not be permitted to participate in the congregational votes. If you revoke your proxy after the commencement of the meeting, you will be counted towards the quorum, but you will not be permitted to participate in the congregational votes.
