**Important voting rules you should know:**

Each member has one vote. A husband and wife, or life partners, who are both members each has one vote. If you want to vote by proxy, you should sign and date this proxy card and return it so that it is received by the Secretary of the Congregation, Elizabeth Mayeri, at [BoardSecretary@nykolami.org](mailto:BoardSecretary@nykolami.org) no later than 5:00pm on March 28<sup>th</sup>. Each voter must sign his or her own proxy. For example, a husband and wife who both want to vote by proxy must each sign a separate proxy.

You may revoke this proxy at any time by sending an email to the Secretary of the Congregation, Elizabeth Mayeri, at [BoardSecretary@nykolami.org](mailto:BoardSecretary@nykolami.org), stating that you want to revoke your proxy. If you revoke your proxy prior to the commencement of the meeting, you will not be counted towards the quorum, and you will not be permitted to participate in the congregational vote. If you revoke your proxy after the commencement of the meeting, you will be counted towards the quorum, but you will not be permitted to participate in the congregational vote.
