Important voting rules you should know:

Each member has one vote. A husband and wife, or life partners, who are both members each has one vote. If you want to vote by proxy, you should sign and date this proxy card and return it so that it is received by the Secretary of the Congregation, Jared Stone, at BoardSecretary@nykolami.org no later than 5:00pm on May 7th. Each voter must sign their own proxy. For example, a husband and wife who both want to vote by proxy must each sign a separate proxy.

You may revoke this proxy at any time by sending an email to the Secretary of the Congregation, Jared Stone, at BoardSecretary@nykolami.org, stating that you want to revoke your proxy. If you revoke your proxy prior to the commencement of the meeting, and do not attend in person or via Zoom, you will not be counted towards the quorum, and you will not be permitted to participate in the congregational vote. If you revoke your proxy after the commencement of the meeting, and are not present in person or via Zoom, you will be counted towards the quorum, but you will not be permitted to participate in the congregational vote.
